Caetano, and notably, the Basilica of Bom Jesus which contains the relics of Saint Francis Xavier, which is celebrated every year on 3 December with novenas beginning on 24 November. Mangueshi Temple the temple is dedicated to Bhagavan Manguesh, an incarnation of Shiva. He is also referred to as Saib (The Bhagavan of Goa) by Hindus. Latter resume city tour with Panjim shopping.

Day 06: Half day Beach tour

Buffet breakfast at the hotel/resort.

After breakfast proceeds for a visit to Anjuna beach Vagator Beach Vagator Beach, north of Anjuna, is the center of Goa's trance party scene. Enjoy the day at the beaches.

Day 08: Mumbai Elephanta Caves

Early breakfast at the hotel.

After breakfast proceed to the Getaway of India to board a the ferry for Elephanta Caves around 10 km (6.2 mi) far from Mumbai coastline, Enjoy a one-hour boat ride across sea.

*The **Elephanta Caves** are a network of sculpted caves located on Elephanta Island, or Gharapuri (literally "the city of caves") located on an arm of the Arabian Sea, consists of two groups of caves—the first is a large group of five Hindu caves, the second, a smaller group of two Buddhist caves. The Hindu caves contain rock cut stone sculptures, representing the Shaiva Hindu sect, dedicated to the god Shiva. The rock cut architecture of the caves has been dated to between the 5th and 8th centuries, although the identity of the original builders is still a subject of debate. The caves are hewn from solid basalt rock. All the caves were also originally painted in the past, but now only traces remain.*

Latter in the afternoon return back to Mumbai & proceed for shopping at Kolaba...

Day 09: Departure
